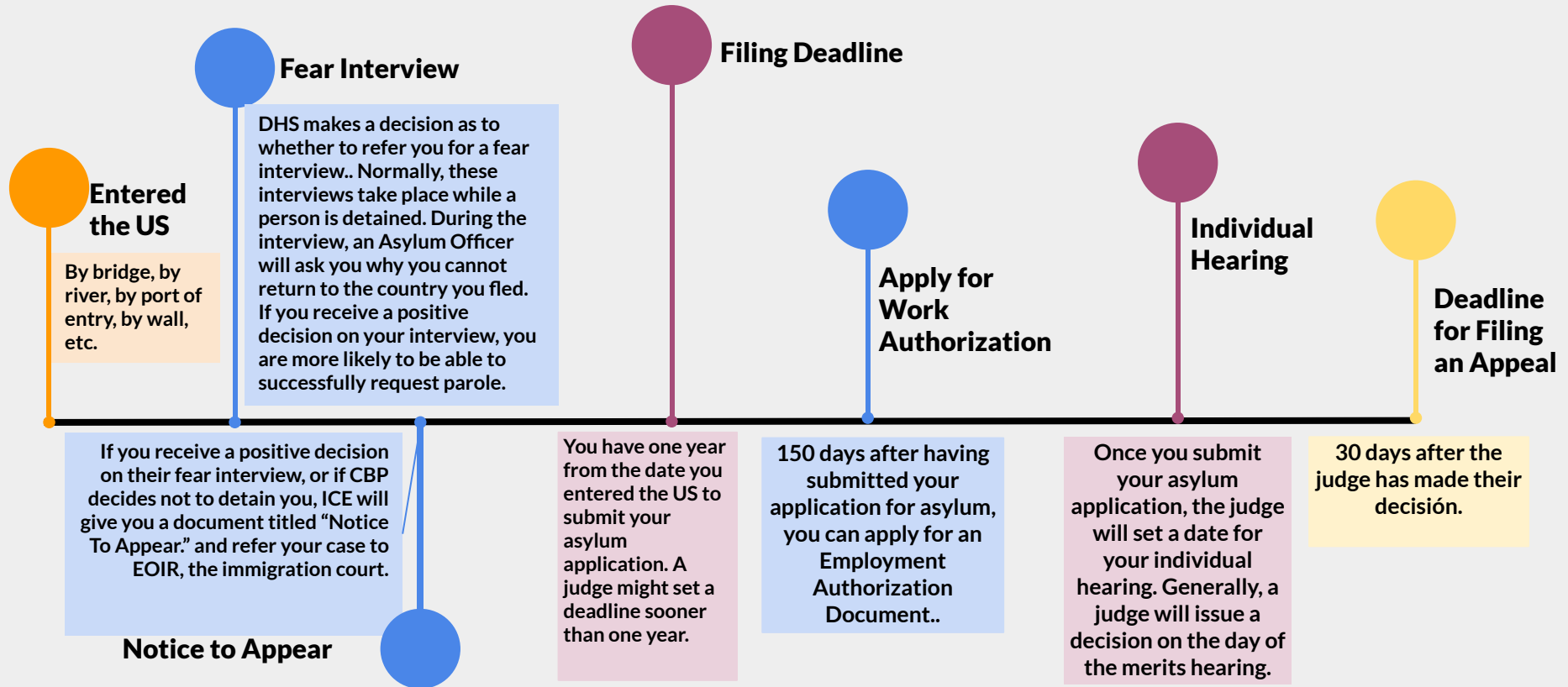


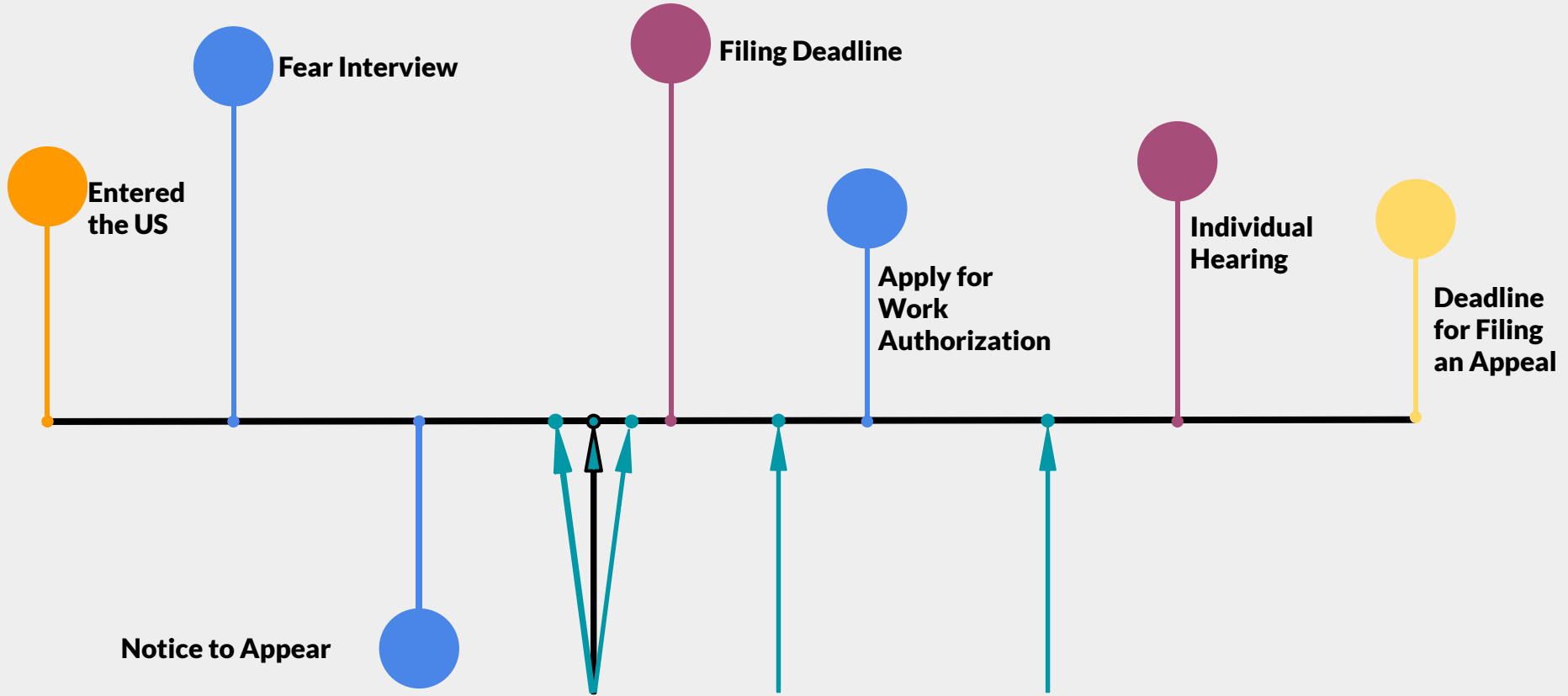

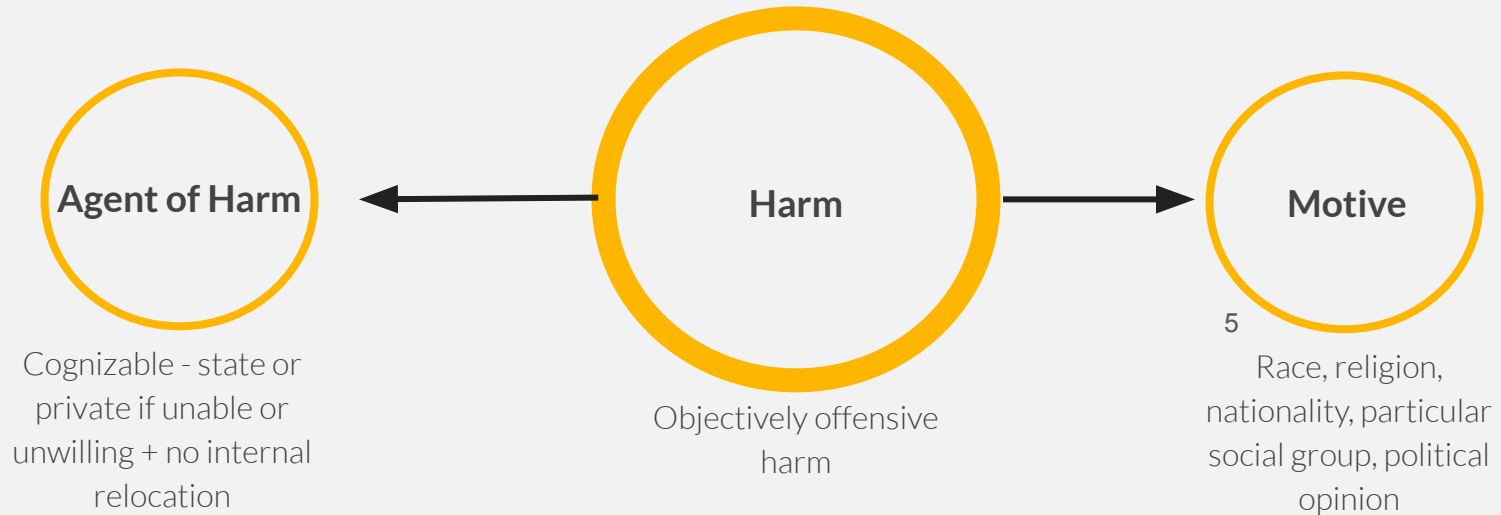

# finding the **refugee**

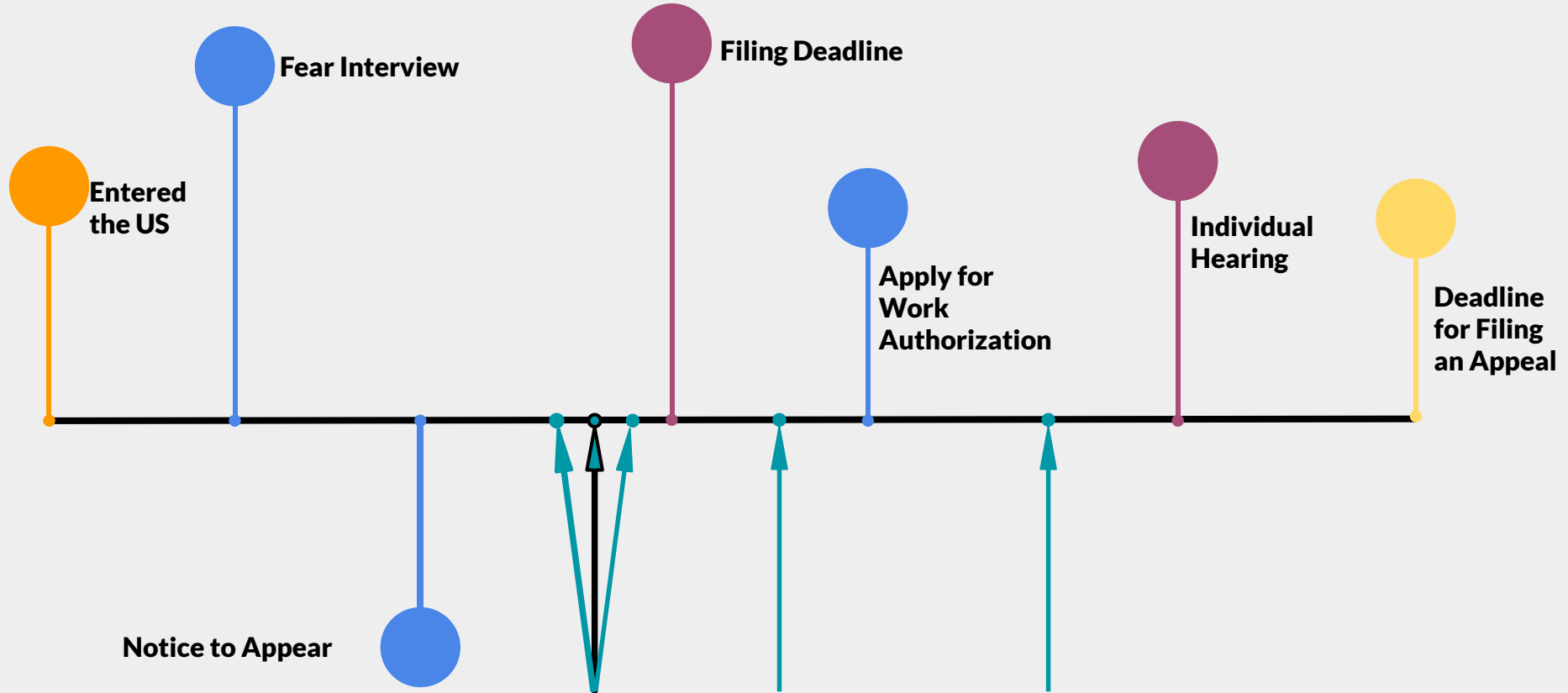
... who is outside any country of such person's nationality or, in the case of a person having no nationality, is outside any country in which such person last habitually resided, and who is unable or unwilling to return to, and is **unable or unwilling to avail himself or herself of the protection of, that country** because of **persecution or a well-founded fear of persecution** on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.

# Claim Development - Ask and listen

1. Review the checklist - a step by step guide
2. Workstation prep - make sure you have what you need
3. Review the record - what information has already been recorded?
4. First call - introduce yourself, set expectations, ask, and listen
5. Case rounds - summarize narrative and troubleshoot claim dev
6. Follow up call - call back, ask follow up qs, finalize narrative
7. Claim Development - Review the narrative and use the asylum assistant to identify claims
